
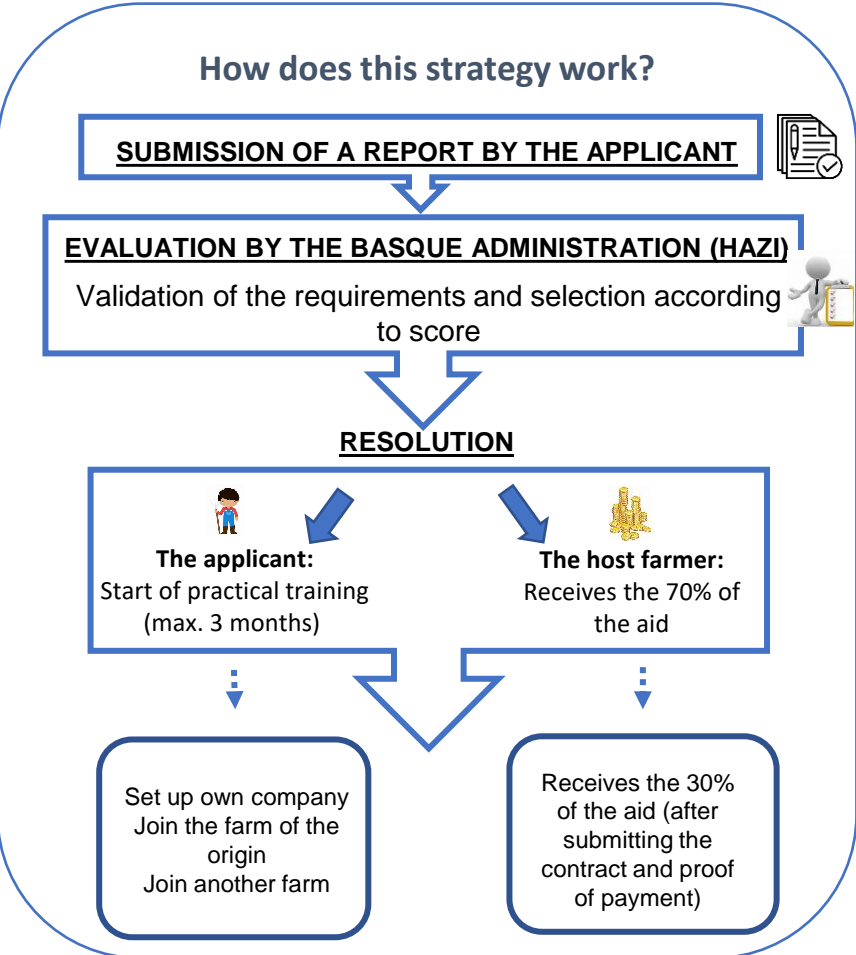


Grants to promote knowledge dissemination, skills enhancement and opportunity identification

Background

Provide financial aid to hire, promote and encourage people to work in the agricultural sector, food industry and rural environment. This can be carried out by teaching trainees in the management, operation and reality of the agriculture and agri-food sector and thus achieving the transfer of knowledge.




- ### Grant requirements
- ✓ Present a business plan (explanation of objectives to be achieved).
 - ✓ To carry out practical training in agricultural/agro-food companies of the region .
 - ✓ Only applications from people who have not been previous beneficiaries of such funding.
 - ✓ Agree on a company-worker work schedule.
 - ✓ Maximum duration of this practical training: 3 months

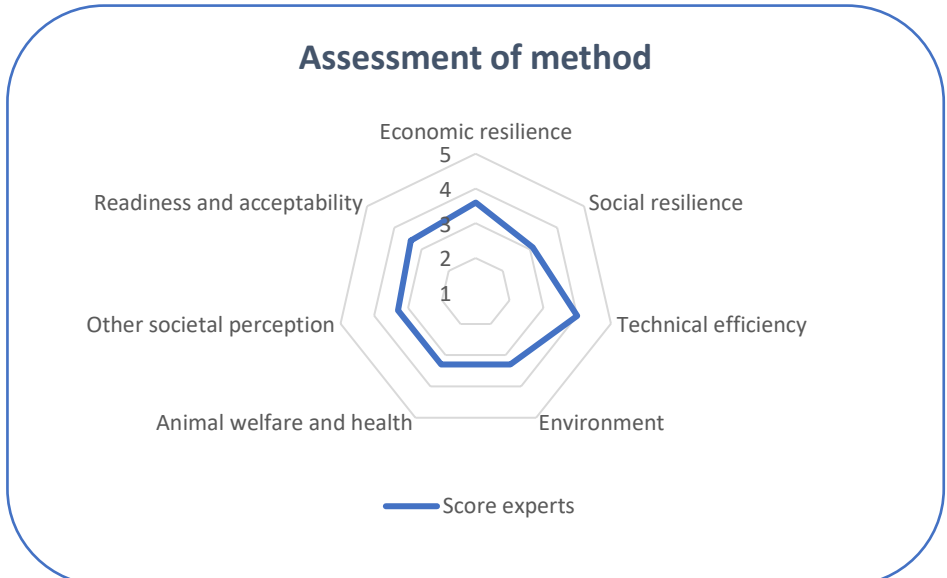

- ### Evaluation criteria
- Applications selected on the basis of a non-cumulative scoring system:
- I. Registered in Gaztenek (primary sector): **30 points**
 - II. Participants in entrepreneurship support programmes in the food and rural value chain: **30 points**
 - III. Participant in Geroa (entrepreneurship in rural and coastal areas): **20 points**
 - IV. Young farmer: **10 points**
- Consistency between the grant and the applicant's report: **0 to 15 points**
 Business plan: **0 to 20 p**
 Female entrepreneurs: **15 p**
 Adequacy of the professional profile: **0 to 10 p**
