This thematic network funded by **EU Horizon 2020 programme** was launched in January 2021. **18 organisations from 15 European countries** cooperate with the objectives to strengthen the exchange between farmers, researchers and relevant actors of the dairy sector and to share ideas and solutions through the cross-fertilisation of stakeholders.

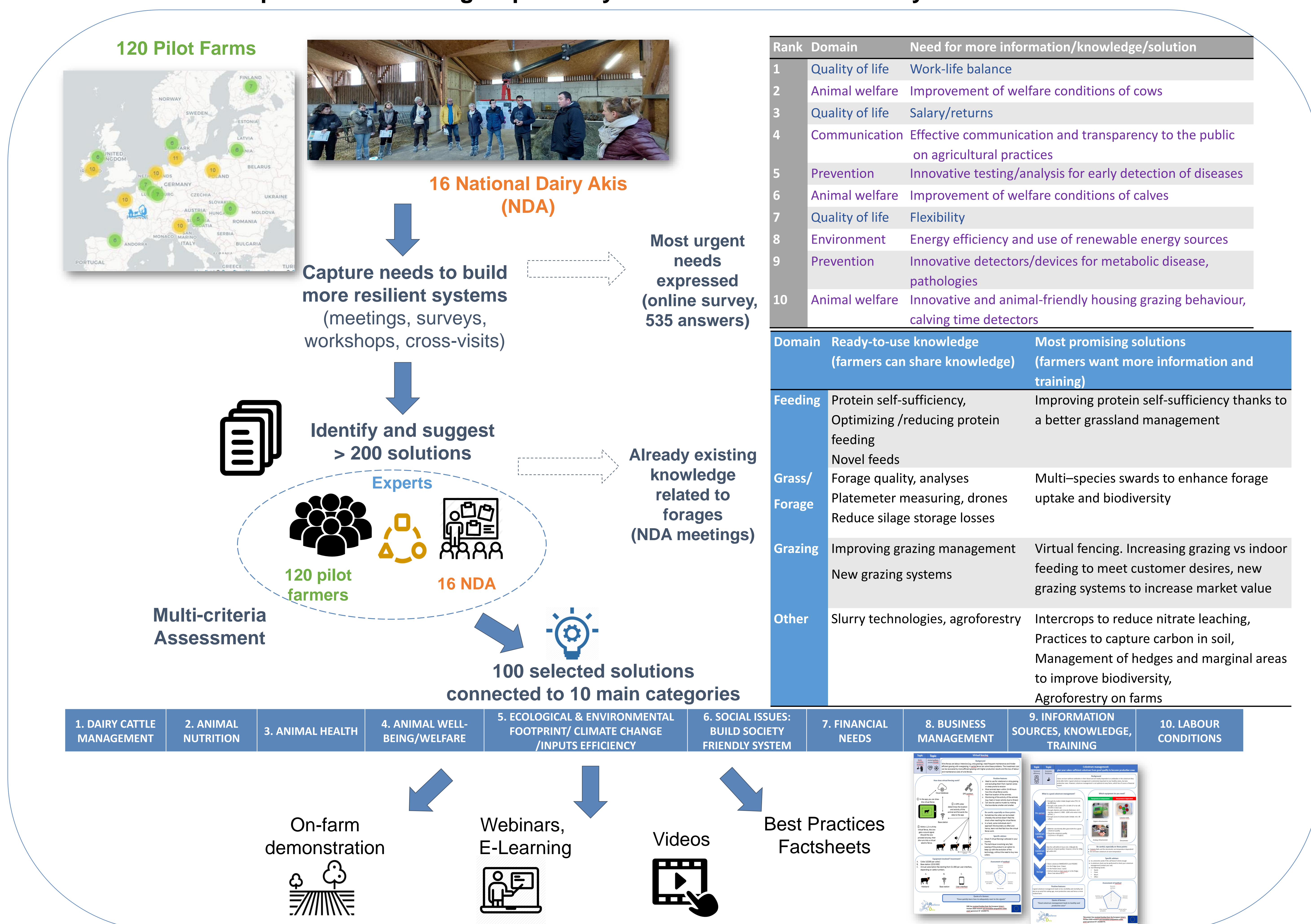
R4D focuses on **three knowledge areas** to enhance dairy farms' sustainability and resilience:
