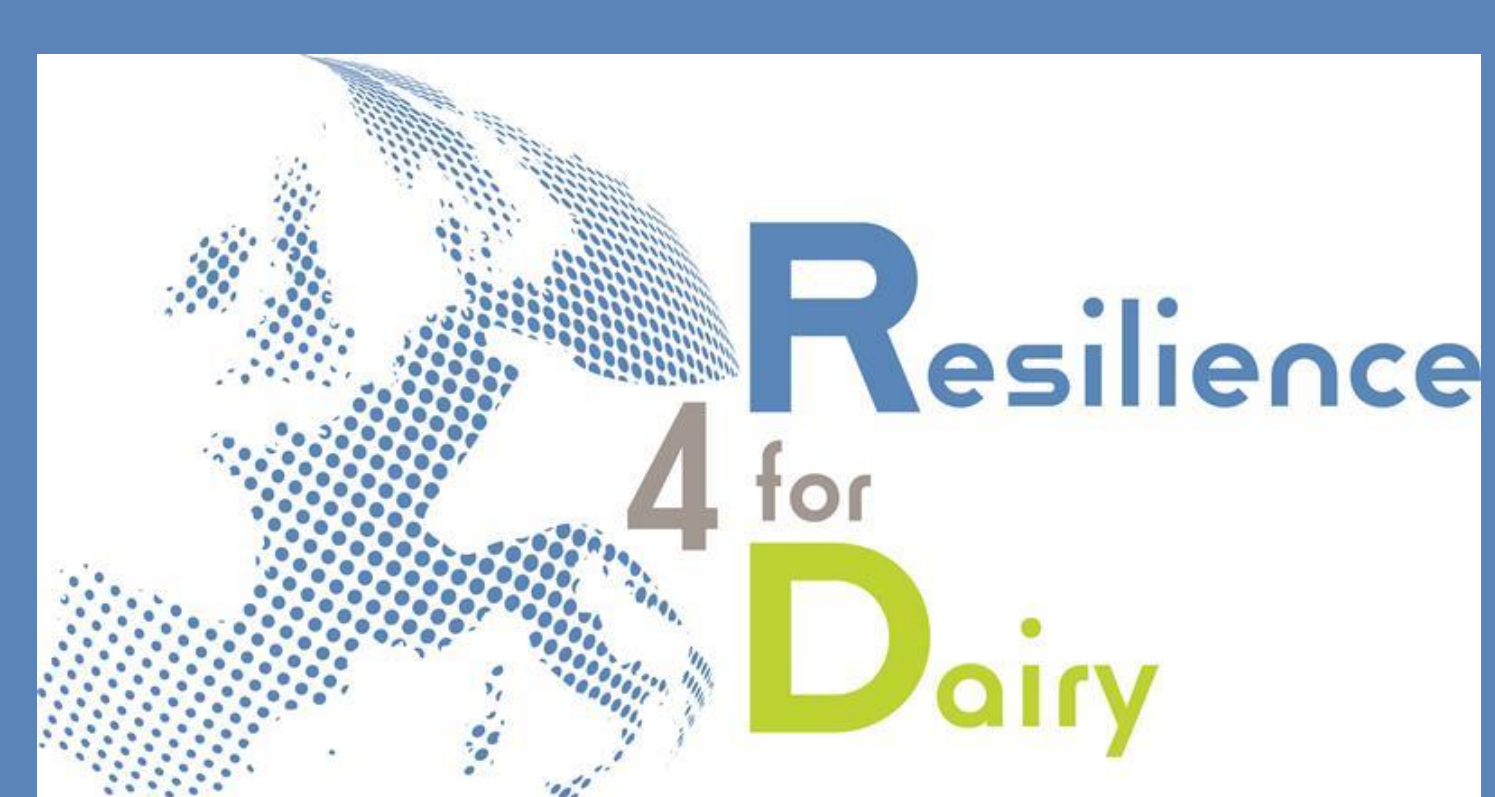




RESILIENCE FOR DAIRY (R4D), A JOURNEY TOWARDS SUSTAINABLE FARMING



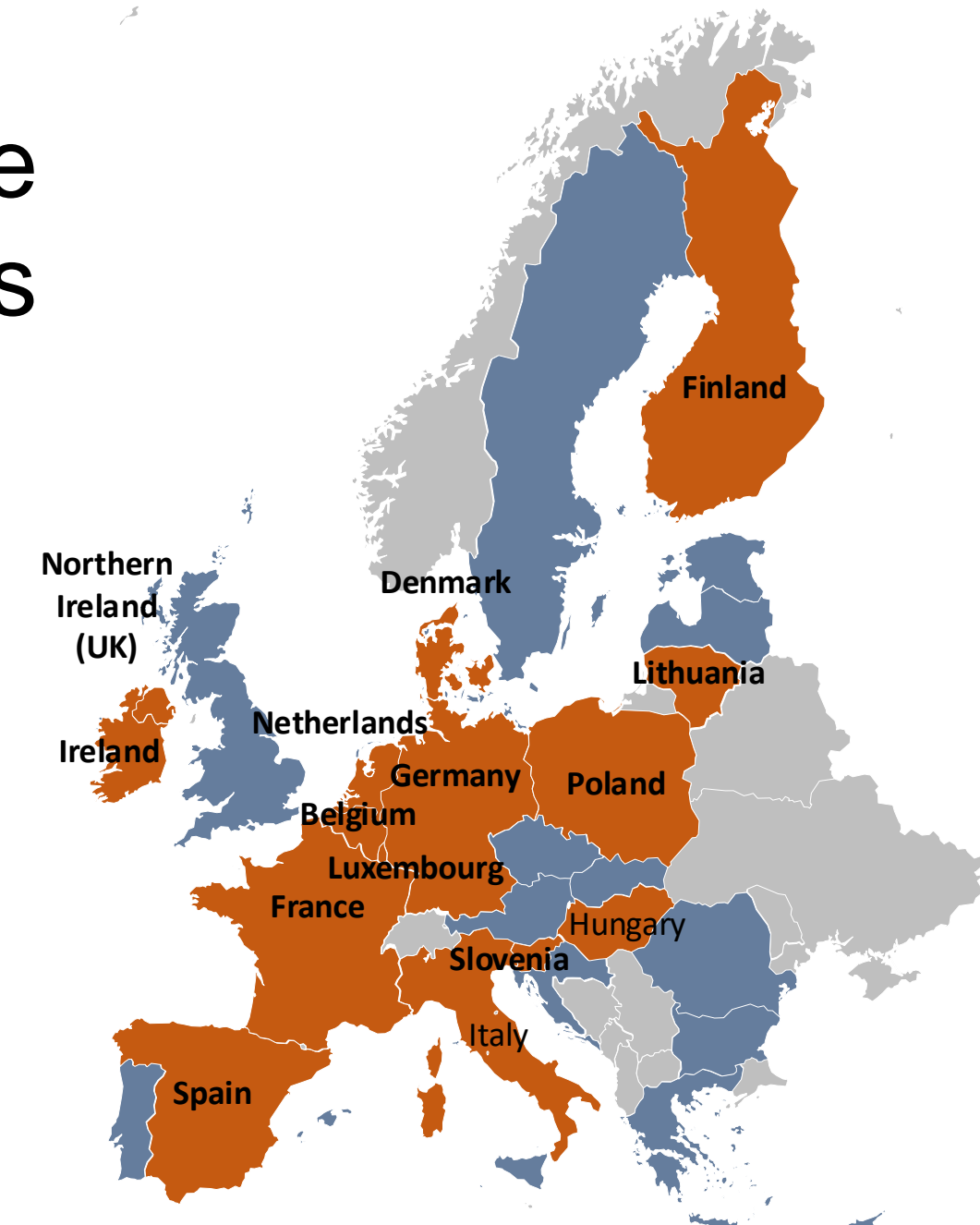
Resilience for Dairy (R4D) has received funding from the European Union's Horizon 2020 research and innovation programme under grant agreement No 101000770

R4D IS AN EUROPEAN PROJECT TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE SOCIAL, ECONOMIC AND ENVIRONMENTAL DEVELOPMENT OF DAIRY FARMING.

This thematic network funded by **EU Horizon 2020 programme** was launched in January 2021. **18 organisations from 15 European countries** cooperate with the objectives to strengthen the exchange between farmers, researchers and relevant actors of the dairy sector and to share ideas and solutions through the cross-fertilisation of stakeholders.

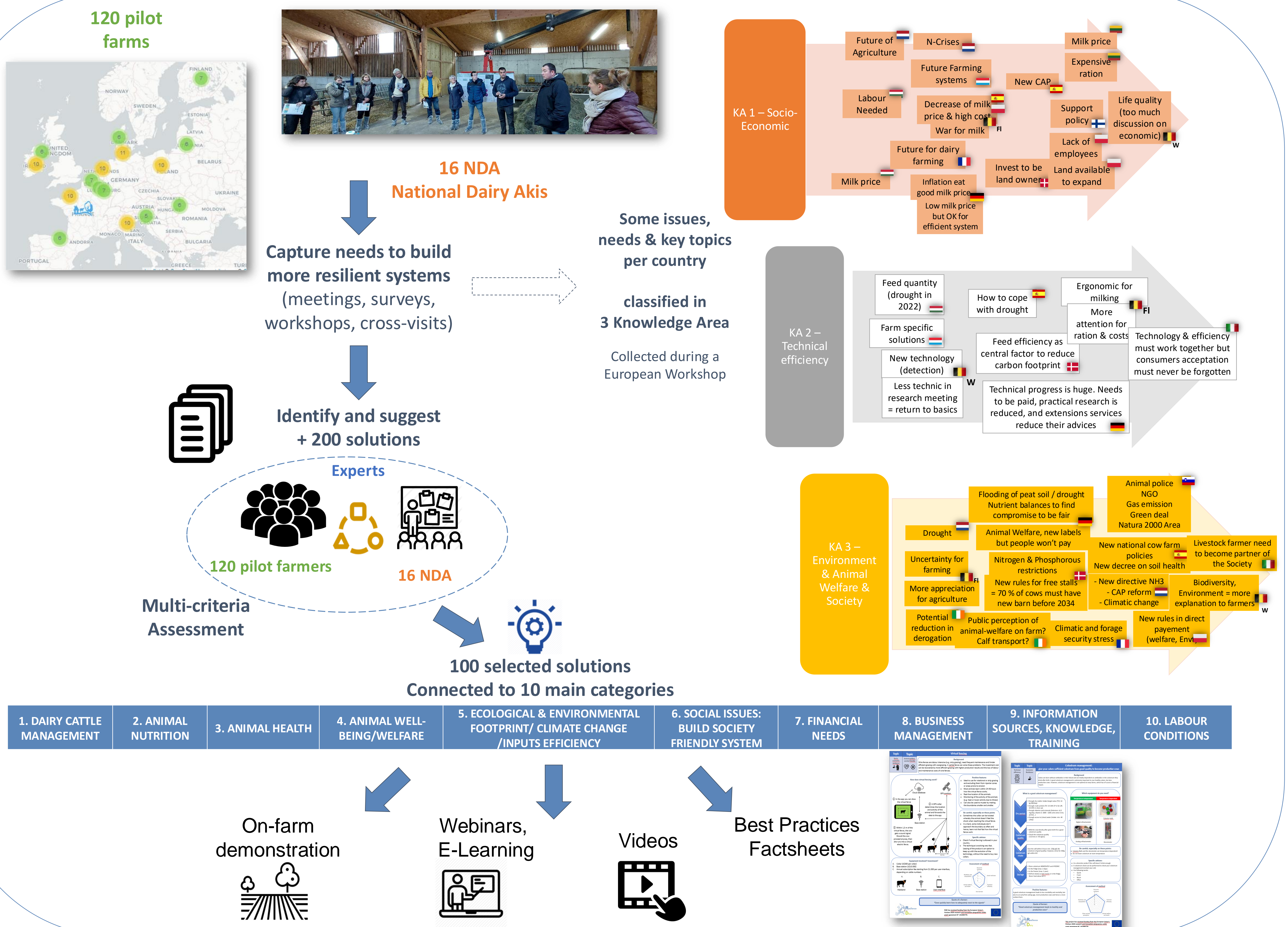
R4D focus on **three knowledge areas** in order to enhance dairy farms' sustainability and resilience:
